
I wish to thank the Mad River Township Trustees for their support and confidence in the department. Their continuous support helps us strive towards future progression at being one of the finest departments in our area.


## **Organizational Chart**



## **Response Statistics**

The department responded to 1920 calls for service in 2022, of those runs 81.2% were for medical calls and 18.8% were for fire responses.

In 2022 the department had 393 overlapping calls, which was 20.47% of the total incidents.




